After working in her home country, Venezuela, for 23 years—mobilizing the church in Venezuela and throughout the rest of Latin America, as well as in cross-cultural missions and children’s outreach—Belkys Moreno is now in Spain, specifically in Madrid, where she is a member of the National Coordination Team for Simply Mobilizing and serves as the Global Coordinator of Spanish Translations for the organization.

She arrived in Spain in October 2023, and since then her ministry has consisted of earning the right to be heard and carrying out her duties in translating all of Simply Mobilizing’s resources.

Her goal remains the same as the one God set for her when He called her to be a mobilizer in 2009. To see every believer living a life of mission with God.

She dreams of seeing true disciples of Jesus making disciples, expanding the kingdom as naturally as the early church did.

Her goal is to make disciples in Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and the ends of the earth, and Spain is the best place to do the ends of the earth, and Spain is the perfect place to achieve this. With the large influx of immigrants, the “ends of the earth” are mingling with Spaniards, Latin Americans, people from Eastern Europe—in short, people whom God has brought here to make travel easier and more affordable.

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By coming here, she has accepted the challenge of exploring a different kind of “jungle”—one that is completely unknown to her, but not to the One who brought her here. This is slow but exciting work that requires total commitment, adaptation to the culture and its rhythms, flexibility, and tenacity. But she is convinced that, just as it was worth navigating dangerous rivers, walking through the jungle, interacting with so many different ethnic groups, and learning to love the diversity that God created, any effort and any discomfort will also be worth it if, by God’s grace, she can see the Spanish church awaken to the reality before its eyes—the magnificent possibility of making disciples to the ends of the earth.

She thanks God for the courses whose translations are already available in Spanish, for the churches that are already in the process, and for those the Lord will bring.
