Since my last letter at the end of last year, my grandson Tomás's health has improved considerably; tests, electrocardiograms, and lumbar punctures have not revealed anything abnormal.

On January 8, I began my search for employment. Miraculously, God has provided for the payment of rent, insurance, medicine, and food; the result is a true testimony to His faithfulness.

A missionary agency has started sending me translations, which, although not very long, provide some income.

I am still looking for work, but here, people bluntly tell me that I am too old to work, that my age is a significant obstacle, and that I have no way to prove my qualifications.

What have I done so far?

I am looking for courses subsidized by the Community of Madrid to train in telecare, care for the elderly in institutions, or intercultural management.

The courses, which last 3 to 4 months, still require my daily attention.

Ministry

By God's grace, we have continued to make progress in reviewing and dubbing the Empowered to Influence (EPI) course, which was translated by the Simply Mobilizing Latino team in North America.

We have finished translating and dubbing Interface 2.0 and its workshops, and we hope to conduct some pilot courses in the near future.

As the National Coordination Team, we are preparing for the launch of the youth mobilization program, with the participation of the global director of youth mobilization for Simply Mobilizing International.



At my church, as of February 1, I rejoined the cafeteria service on the first Sunday of each month and the evangelism ministry, and we continue to meet in the prayer group. I am also attending a home group that meets on Wednesday mornings.
