Having been on several missions trips to Puerto Rico, the calling became clear. To reach and serve the people in Puerto Rico affected by addiction. From the addict on the street to the person in recovery, their family, and friends.

The gap that we must fill is vast due to the lack of resources. Just trying to get to a detox clinic if you want to get clean can be a daunting task. However, in Christ Jesus, my beautiful wife Wanda and I pledge to stand in the gap.

In addition to learning Spanish (Si es verdad, ahora puedo hablar español, pero todavía necesito aprender mucho más). We have started to connect with other ministries, detoxes, group homes, churches, Politicians, and organizations that serve people affected by addiction to better understand the needs and how we can assist.

We wish to acquire a building in Mayaguez, Puerto Rico, to offer a food pantry, 12-step meetings, workshops, vocational classes, employment readiness programs, bible studies, etc. Also, we wish to acquire a van to conduct street outreach and transport those needing detox and or sober living, etc.

I have written and published a book called: "90 in 90 A 90-Day Daily Devotional for Christians in Recovery" to help raise support for the ministry.

We are currently 14% funded and praying to be fully funded soon. Please help us pray that more people decide to join us in this venture.
