We have a group of Argentine facilitators who want to continue growing and acquiring knowledge, to improve their ability to disciple others, so in April we will start the second stage of facilitator development to train Head Facilitators in the country, able to lead courses and training new facilitators who might also share the vision of mobilizing believers to reach those who have not yet heard the gospel. This would be the third level of training for facilitators, which would allow us to strengthen the Simply Mobilizing team in the country.

At the same time, we continue organizing courses for this year to be able to cover the needs of mobilization and missionary vision within the Argentine churches, for which we give glory to God, since there is a desire and need on the part of the churches to be trained and involved, which only can come from Him. For this year we already have scheduled the course "Xplore", "The Unfinished Story", "Kairos", "Mobi101", "Go to mobilize", "Interface" and "Send me" every type of course we offer is to cover different needs and different types of people so that multiplication can be more effective and we hope to see a significant increase in Argentines going out to work and planting new churches where there are none.

### ***Training for a better service.***

At the end of March, Daniel attended the international conference for OM's leaders, where they worked on how to carry out the vision of the organization in its intention to make Jesus known among the least reached. It was also a good opportunity to meet old ministry friends from Logos Hope (ship ministry) and learn what God is doing in other places, and how we can contribute to his work in the most effective way as possible.
