Intercession (Hymns Inclusive)

The congregation joins in prayer and worship through hymns while interceding for individuals, families, communities, the nation, ministry partners, and the advancement of the Gospel.

Divine Worship Service (Hymns Inclusive)

A time of joyful worship through hymns, praise, thanksgiving, and reverence before God.

Offerings

Members present their tithes, offerings, thanksgiving gifts, and other voluntary contributions as an act of worship and faithful stewardship.

Special Songs

Choirs, worship teams, youth, children, or individual members may present songs that glorify God and encourage the congregation.

Testimonies

Members are given an opportunity to testify about God's faithfulness, answered prayers, healing, deliverance, or other blessings received.

Weekly Sermon

The preacher delivers the main biblical message, calling believers to repentance, spiritual maturity, obedience to God's Word, and faithful Christian living.

Announcements

Important ministry information, upcoming programmes, meetings, outreach activities, and other notices are communicated to the congregation.

Closing Prayer

The service concludes with prayer, thanksgiving, and a blessing upon the congregation before dismissal.

CHAPTER EIGHT

FUNERAL MINISTRY PROTOCOL

8.1 Introduction

Book of Life (BOL) Ministry considers funeral ministry an important act of Christian compassion. During bereavement, the Church stands together with grieving families by providing spiritual encouragement, pastoral care, prayer, and practical support.

Funeral services are conducted respectfully, orderly, and in accordance with biblical principles while comforting the bereaved and proclaiming the hope found in the Messiah.

8.2 Night Vigil (Optional)

Where appropriate and in agreement with the bereaved family:

- Church members may gather during the night for worship, hymns, prayer, Scripture reading, and words of encouragement.
- Members should maintain order, respect, and compassion throughout the gathering.

8.3 Funeral Service Programme

Morning

- 09:00 Hours
- The Pastor arrives at the bereaved family's home.
- Prayer at the House
- The Pastor offers prayer with the family, encouraging them through the Word of God.
- Church Prayer Service
- The church conducts a prayer service specifically for the bereaved family and all those affected by the loss.

Community Programme

Community leaders, family representatives, traditional leaders, and other guests may deliver their messages of condolence according to the programme.

✓ *Sermon*

The Pastor or appointed minister preaches the Gospel, bringing hope, comfort, and biblical encouragement.

✓ *Procession to the Cemetery*

The congregation accompanies the body respectfully to the burial site.

8.4 Graveside Service

1. At the cemetery, the Pastor conducts the burial service which includes:

- ✓ Opening prayer.
- ✓ Scripture reading.
- ✓ Graveside sermon.
- ✓ Final prayers.
- ✓ Committal of the body.
- ✓ Burial.
- ✓ Wreath laying by family members, church leaders, friends, and other mourners.
- ✓ Invitation for the bereaved family to gather around the grave.
- ✓ Final prayer and blessing.
- ✓ Dismissal.

8.5 Responsibilities of Church Members

Members are encouraged to:
