

## JUSTICE AND MERCY: WALKING HUMBLY WITH GOD

When the prophet Micah penned those timeless words—"to act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God"—he wasn't offering suggestions for spiritual improvement. He was unveiling the essence of what God expects from His people. In a world fractured by injustice, inequality, and indifference, these words resonate with urgent clarity. Social justice isn't a modern trend or political agenda; it's woven into the fabric of God's character and inseparable from the Gospel message we're called to share. Understanding this truth transforms how we view missions, ministry, and our responsibility to the hurting world around us.

### The Divine Blueprint: Justice as God's Nature

Justice flows from who God is. Throughout Scripture, we see a God who defends the orphan, provides for the widow, and stands with the oppressed. From the Exodus to the prophets' thundering declarations, God consistently positions Himself on the side of the vulnerable. It recognizes that the woman trapped in poverty, the child without clean water, and the refugee fleeing violence—each bears God's image and deserves dignity. Missionaries worldwide embody this merciful love daily, sitting with the broken, offering hope where despair has taken root, and demonstrating through tangible action that God hasn't forgotten His people. They understand

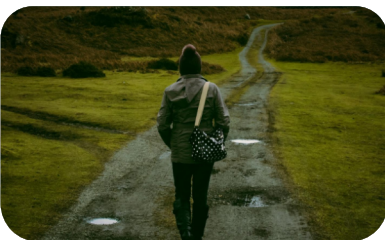

This posture prevents the paternalism that has sometimes plagued mission work and instead fosters genuine transformation. Humility also keeps us dependent on God, acknowledging that lasting change requires His power, not merely our programs.
